**MODIFICATION OF CONSENT ORDER**

WHEREAS, Linda Kasowitz of West Haven (hereinafter "respondent") entered into a Consent Order on March 1, 2000, which became effective on April 1, 2000, (a true and complete copy of which is attached hereto marked as Attachment "A"); and,

WHEREAS, respondent and the Department wish to modify the aforementioned Consent Order;

NOW THEREFORE, paragraph 3 of the Consent Order is amended as follows:

- 3. Respondent's license number E50284 to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby placed on probation for five years, subject to the following terms and conditions:
- 3B(3). There must be at least one such observed random alcohol/drug screen and accompanying laboratory report every week until December 18, 2003; at least two such screens and reports per month from December 18, 2003 until April 1, 2004; and at least one such screen per week during the fifth year of probation.

3G. Respondent shall not administer, count or have access to narcotics or other controlled substances, or have responsibility for such activities in the course of her nursing duties until June 18, 2003.

All other remaining terms and conditions of the Consent Order remain in effect. This Modification of Consent Order is effective upon the order and acceptance of the Board of Examiners for Nursing.

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I, Linda Kasowitz, have read the foregoing Modification of Consent Order, and I agree to the terms and conditions therein. I further declare the execution of this document to be my free act and deed.


