Dana Belliveau, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. I am licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice registered nursing. I presently hold license number E52138.
4. I hereby voluntarily surrender my license to practice registered nursing in the State of Connecticut.
5. I understand and agree that if I seek a new license or to reinstate my license at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 2000-1212-010-076 shall be deemed true. I further understand that any such application must be made to the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") and the Department, and that the Board shall be a signatory to any order reinstating my license or granting me a new license.
6. I hereby waive any right to a hearing I may have regarding any request that my license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that I may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. I understand and agree that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 2000-1212-010-076 are public documents, and I am executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. I understand that this surrender of my license is a reportable event and is public information.
9. I understand that, upon execution of this document by the Department, the Department will present this document to the Board and will move to withdraw the Statement of Charges in Petition No. 2000-1212-012-076. I understand that this document is not effective unless and until the Department has executed it, and the Board either grants the Department's Motion to Withdraw or the charges are dismissed.

10. I understand that I have the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.


MOTION TO WITHDRAW STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Comes now the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") and hereby moves the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") for an Order granting this Motion to Withdraw. As grounds for this Motion, the Department states that on February 12, 2001, respondent signed a Voluntary Surrender of License Affidavit. A copy of respondent's Affidavit is attached hereto marked as Attachment "A." The Department has accepted respondent's Affidavit and license.

In accordance with Section 19a-14-1 et seq. of the Public Health Code, if respondent applies for reinstatement of her license at any time in the future, the Board shall determine whether or not such application is granted and, if so, whether terms and conditions shall be imposed.

Respondent has voluntarily given up her right to practice as a registered nurse in Connecticut with the Department's approval. For this reason, the Department believes that continued prosecution of this case is unnecessary, and that it is in the interests of justice and administrative economy to terminate these proceedings at this time.



SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER


WHEREAS, the affidavits, duly verified, allege facts which show violations of §20-99(b)(2) and (5) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and which imperatively require emergency action in that the public health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the State of Connecticut is in clear and immediate danger; and,

Pursuant to the authority of §4-182(c) and §19a-17(c), pending the hearing set for the 7th day of FEBRUARY, ²⁰⁰¹~~2000~~, at 1:00 PM a.m.

It is hereby ORDERED, by vote of the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") that license number E52138 of Dana Belliveau to practice registered nursing in the State of Connecticut is summarily suspended pending a final determination by the Board regarding the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Dana Belliveau:

1. Dana Belliveau of Killingworth (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut Registered Nurse license number E52138.
2. Respondent's license was issued on August 24, 1989.
3. Respondent entered into a Consent Order, Petition No. 990609-010-047 on September 15, 1999.
4. The Consent Order states that respondent shall not use alcohol in any form unless prescribed by a licensed health care professional authorized to prescribe medications.
5. On October 27, 2000, November 20, 2000 and November 29, 2000 respondent tested positive for alcohol.
6. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-99(b) including but not limited to:
 - a. §20-99 (b)(2); and/or
 - b. §20-99(b)(5).

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THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Board of Examiners for Nursing, as authorized in §§19a-17 and 20-99(b), revoke or order other disciplinary action against the Registered Nurse license of Dana Belliveau as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
