REINSTATEMENT CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Mary Ellen Greene of Mystic, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") has requested reinstatement of her license number E55728 to practice Registered Nursing by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent's license was voluntarily surrendered on September 17, 1998, and respondent has now applied to have said license reinstated by the Department pursuant to Chapter 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent hereby admits as follows:

1. That on September 17, 1998, she voluntarily surrendered her license based on allegations that she failed to maintain minimal standards.
2. That the conduct described above constitutes grounds for denial of respondent's application for reinstatement pursuant to §19a-14(a)(6) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §§19a-17 and 20-99 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, respondent hereby stipulates and agrees as follows:

1. She waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.

2. Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse shall be reinstated when she satisfies the requirements for reinstatement of her license, as set forth in §§ 19a-14-1 through 19a-14-5, inclusive, of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, and this Reinstatement Consent Order is executed by all parties.
3. Immediately upon issuance, respondent's license number E55728 to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby placed on probation for four years, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - A. Respondent shall be responsible for the provision of monthly written reports directly to the Department from her nursing supervisor (i.e., Director of Nursing) for the four years of her probation. Employer reports shall include documentation of respondent's nursing skills and her ability to safely and competently practice as a registered nurse, and shall be issued to the Department at the address below:

 - B. Respondent shall provide a copy of this Reinstatement Order to all current and future employers for the duration of her probation.
 - C. Respondent shall successfully complete a Board approved registered nurse refresher program within nine months of the effective date of this Reinstatement Order. Certification of successful completion of the refresher program shall be submitted to the Board directly from

the educational institution from which said program was taken within thirty (30) days of the program's completion.

- D. Respondent shall not accept employment as a registered nurse for a personnel provider service, Assisted Living Services Agency, Homemaker-Home Health Aide Agency, or a home health care agency, and shall not be self-employed as a nurse for the period of her probation, but shall be in a supervised situation.
4. Respondent shall comply with all federal and state statutes and regulations applicable to her license.
 5. Respondent shall notify the Department of any change(s) in her employment within fifteen (15) days of such change.
 6. Respondent shall notify the Department of any change in her home and/or business address within fifteen (15) days of such change.
 7. Legal notice shall be sufficient if sent to respondent's last known address of record reported to the Licensure and Registration Section of the Division of Health Systems Regulation of the Department.
 8. Respondent understands this Reinstatement Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above-admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut State Board of Examiners for Nursing in which (1) her compliance with this Reinstatement Consent Order is at issue, or (2) her compliance with §20-99 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
 9. This Reinstatement Consent Order and the terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Reinstatement Consent Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of

Chapters 54 or 368a of the Connecticut General Statutes provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

10. This Reinstatement Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement, which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
11. This Reinstatement Consent Order is effective when accepted and approved by a duly appointed agent of the Department.
12. Respondent has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.
13. This Reinstatement Consent Order is a matter of public record.

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I, Mary Ellen Greene, have read the above Reinstatement Consent Order, and I agree to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Reinstatement Consent Order to be my free act and deed.


