CONSENT ORDER

WHISEAS, Jeffrey Richards (hereinafter "respondent") of New Haven, Connecticut has been issued license number E55794 to practice as a registered nurse by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Department alleges that:

1. In March, 2000, respondent failed to treat a patient who was complaining of chest pain within the standard of care by failing to reassess his medical condition in a timely manner.
2. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, 20-99(b)(2).

WHISEAS, respondent, in consideration of this Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the above allegations at a hearing in front of the Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board").

Respondent does not admit to having violated any statute or regulation, including but not limited to §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut. Respondent further agrees that this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if ordered after a full hearing pursuant to §§19a-9, 19a-10, and 20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

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NOW THISEFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. Respondent waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. Respondent shall comply with all federal and state statutes and regulations applicable to his profession.
3. Respondent's license number E55794 to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby reprimanded.
4. Legal notice of any action shall be deemed sufficient if sent to respondent's last known address of record reported to the Licensure and Registration Section of the Division of Health Systems Regulation of the Department.
5. This Consent Order is effective on the first day of the month immediately following the month in which this Consent Order is approved and accepted by the Board.
6. Respondent understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
7. The Department's allegations as contained in this Consent Order shall be deemed true in any subsequent proceeding before the Board in which (1) his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) his/his compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
8. In the event respondent violates any term of this Consent Order, said violation may also constitute grounds for the Department to seek a summary suspension of respondent's license before the Board.
9. This Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Consent Order is not

subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any of his rights that respondent may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

10. Respondent permits a representative of the Department to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. The Department and respondent understand that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
11. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Jeffrey Richards, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree to the terms set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
