
VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE AFFIDAVIT

Leo Gonzales, R.N., being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. I am licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice as a registered nurse. I presently hold license number E63012.
4. I hereby voluntarily surrender my license to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Connecticut.
5. While not admitting any guilt or wrongdoing, I understand and agree that if I seek a new license or to reinstate my license at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 2011-724 shall be deemed true. I further understand that any such application must be made to the Department which shall have absolute discretion, after seeking the advice of the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board"), as to whether said license shall be issued or reinstated and, if so, whether said license shall be subject to conditions. No reinstatement shall become effective until the Department seeks the advice of the Board.
6. I hereby waive any right to a hearing I may have regarding any request that my license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that I may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. I understand and agree that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 2011-724 are public documents, and I am executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. I understand that this surrender of my license is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and is public information.
10. I understand that, upon execution of this document by the Department, the Department will present this document to the Board and will move to withdraw the Statement of Charges in Petition No. 2011-724. I understand that this document is not effective unless and until the

Department has executed it, and the Board either grants the Department's Motion to Withdraw or the charges are dismissed.

11. I have consulted with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.
12. I understand that the execution of this document has no bearing on any criminal liability without the written consent of the Director of the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit or the State's Attorney's Office where the allegation occurred or Bureau Chief of the applicable unit in the Chief State's Attorney's Office. The purpose of this Consent Order is to resolve the pending administrative license disciplinary petition only, and is not intended to affect any civil or criminal liability or defense.

**MOTION TO WITHDRAW STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

Comes now the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") and hereby moves the Board Of Examiners For Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") for an Order granting this Motion to Withdraw. As grounds for this Motion, the Department states that on March 6, 2012, respondent signed a Voluntary Surrender of License Affidavit. A copy of respondent's Affidavit is attached hereto marked as Attachment "A." The Department has accepted respondent's Affidavit and license.

In accordance with Section 19a-14-1 et seq. of the Public Health Code and at the Board's request, if respondent applies for reinstatement of his registered nurse license at any time in the future, the Department shall seek the advice of the Board prior to making a determination regarding such application.

Respondent has voluntarily given up his right to practice as a registered nurse in Connecticut with the Department's approval. For this reason, the Department believes that continued prosecution of this case is unnecessary, and that it is in the interests of justice and administrative economy to terminate these proceedings at this time.
