STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Tamar Delohery:

COUNT ONE

1. Tamar Delohery of Sherman (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut registered nursing license number E60651.
2. During about February 2007, respondent abused or utilized to excess Darvon and/or Darvocet.
3. Respondent's abuse of Darvon and/or Darvocet does, and/or may, affect her practice as a registered nurse.
4. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-99(b), including but not limited to §20-99(b)(5).

COUNT TWO


5. Paragraphs 1-2 are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.
6. On September 6, 2006, the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") ordered a Consent Order in Petition Number 2005-1005-010-080 (hereinafter "the Consent Order") that placed respondent's registered nursing license on probation for a period of four (4) years. Such disciplinary action was based upon proof of respondent's ingestion of Percocet, Atavan and/or Xanax and falsification of controlled substance records.
7. Said Order specifically provided that respondent shall submit to weekly urine screens. The Order requires that all screens shall be negative for the presence of drugs.
8. During February 2007, respondent's urine screen result was positive for Darvon.

9. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes violations of the terms of probation as set forth in the Consent Order, and subjects respondent's license to revocation or other disciplinary action authorized by the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-17 and 20-99(b).

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing, as authorized by the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§20-99(b) and 19a-17, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the license of Tamar Delohery as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
