CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Judith Chalfant, R.N. of Plantsville, Connecticut has been issued license number R25568 to practice as a registered nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 278 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Judith Chalfant hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. On or about June 5, 1987 while employed as a nurse at Woodmere Health Care Center in Southington, Connecticut she failed to initiate appropriate action in response to a licensed nurse's concern that sexual abuse of a patient may have occurred.
2. She is licensed as a nurse in Connecticut, has in the past held a nursing license in Missouri and does not have licensure pending in any other state.
3. The conduct described in 1. above fails to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession in violation of §20-99(1) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Judith Chalfant hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:


1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.

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2. That she is hereby reprimanded.
3. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
4. That she understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
5. That she understands this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing in which her compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
6. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
7. That she permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the basis for said Consent Order to the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing. She understands that the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or granted.
8. That she understands she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Judith Chalfant, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
