CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Kelly Davidson, of Winsted, Connecticut, has been issued license No. R-38167 to practice as a registered nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Kelly Davidson, hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. From approximately January 1985 until approximately June 1985, while employed as a registered nurse at St. Francis Hospital, Hartford, CT, she diverted an unspecified amount of Meperidine.
2. From approximately January 1985 until approximately June 1985, while employed as a registered nurse at St. Francis Hospital, Hartford, CT, she diverted an unspecified amount of Morphine.
3. She is currently licensed in Massachusetts.
4. She does not have licensure pending in any other state.
5. She is currently employed at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford, CT.
6. By her actions described in (1) and (2) above, has violated the provisions of §20-99(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes by failing to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Kelly Davidson, hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That her license to practice as a registered nurse is suspended for a period of two years from the effective date of this Consent Order.
3. That subject to the following conditions precedent, said suspension shall be stayed after six months:
  - a. that she must obtain monthly reports from a licensed therapist, which reports shall indicate that she is drug free,
  - b. that she will undergo random urine screens;
  - c. that the above-mentioned reports and results of the urine screens shall be submitted to:

  - d. that the above-mentioned reports and screen results shall be received no later than the fifth day of each month.
4. That for the remaining eighteen months she shall be on probation, and entitled to practice as a registered nurse conditioned on the terms of probation as follows:
  - a. that she must obtain bi-monthly reports from a licensed therapist, which reports shall indicate that she is practicing nursing in a drug free state;

- b. That she must obtain bi-monthly reports from her supervisor, which reports shall indicate that she is practicing nursing in a drug free state;
- c. that she will undergo random urine screens at her work place;
- d. that the above-mentioned reports and results of the urine screens shall be submitted to:

- e. that the above-mentioned reports and screen results shall be received no later than the fifth day of each month.
  - f. that she is to notify the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing prior to changing her employment during the eighteen month period of probation.
- 5. That she understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
  - 6. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.
  - 7. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Department of Health Services (1) in which her compliance with this order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-99(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, is at issue.

- 8. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapter 54 or 368a of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
- 9. That she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Kelly Davidson, hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
