**CONSENT ORDER**

WHEREAS, Ewa Jurzyk, of Plainville, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") has been issued license number R52025 to practice as a registered nurse by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Decision in Petition No. 2002-0530-010-047, dated April 12, 2003, (a true and complete copy of which is attached hereto marked as Attachment "A") placed respondent's license on probation, and required her to submit to urine screens for the presence of drugs and alcohol, and in January 2005, respondent's urine screen tested positive for morphine, which respondent has attributed to her consumption of poppy seeds.

NOW THEREFORE, the following is added to paragraph 2 under "Order" in the Memorandum of Decision:

2. That for Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the "Order" contained in the Memorandum of Decision, respondent's registered nurse license number R52025 is placed on probation for a period of an additional six (6) months. Thus the total length of probation is four years and six months, from April 15, 2003, the effective date of the Memorandum of Decision.

All other remaining terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Decision remain in effect. This modification of Memorandum of Decision via this Consent Order is effective upon the order and acceptance of the Board.

Respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following

1. Respondent permits a representative of the Department to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. Respondent understands that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
2. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Ewa Jurzyk, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree to the terms set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
