**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER AFFIDAVIT**

Elizabeth King, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. I am licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice as a registered nurse. I presently hold license number R53033.
4. I hereby voluntarily surrender and agree not to renew or reinstate my license to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Connecticut.
5. I understand and agree that if I seek a new license or to reinstate my license at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 991013-010-082 shall be deemed true. I further understand that any such application must be made to the Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board") and the Department, and that the Board shall be a signatory to any order reinstating my license or granting me a new license.
6. I hereby waive any right to a hearing I may have regarding any request that my license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that I may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. I understand and agree that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 991013-010-082 are public documents, and I am executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. I understand that this document has no effect unless and until it is executed by the Department; and that, upon execution, the Department will dismiss Petition No. 991013-010-082.

9. I understand that I have the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.
