STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Jacquelyn Hodgson, L.P.N.:

1. Jacquelyn Hodgson, L.P.N. of Bridgeport (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut licensed practical nurse license number 012730.
2. During the period of approximately July through September of 1999, while she was working at Bridgeport Health Center, respondent diverted several dozen tablets of Percocet, Darvocet, and Tylox for her own use. In addition, respondent falsified or omitted entries on various documents to conceal the diversion.
3. Respondent's use of Percocet, Darvocet, and/or Tylox, does, and/or may, affect her practice as a licensed practical nurse.
4. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-99(b), including but not limited to:


a. §20-99(b)(2) and/or;

b. §20-99(b)(5).

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Board of Examiners for Nursing, as authorized in §§19a-17 and 20-99(b), revoke or order other disciplinary action against the licensed practical nurse's license of Jacquelyn Hodgson as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
