CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Janet M. Reitler of Tampa, Florida has been issued license number 013497 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Janet M. Reitler, hereinafter referred to as the respondent, hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. On June 22, 1989 the Board of Examiners for Nursing reviewed her application for reinstatement of her licensed practical nurse license.
2. On June 22, 1989 the Board of Examiners for Nursing recommended and she was informed of same in correspondence dated June 29, 1989, that said license be reinstated with the condition that certain continuing education course(s) be satisfactorily completed.
3. In correspondence dated June 29, 1989 the respondent was still further informed that any change of address was to be communicated to the Board of Examiners for Nursing.
4. The respondent has failed to satisfactorily complete the continuing education course(s) required by the Board of Examiners for Nursing.

5. The respondent further failed to timely notify the Board of Examiners for Nursing of her change of address which occurred on or about April 1990.
6. She is licensed as a nurse in Connecticut and Florida.
7. The conduct described in 5. and 6. above fails to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession in violation of §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Janet M. Reitler hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That her license number 013497 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby surrendered.
3. That she has heretofore forwarded by mail license #013497, expiration <sup>Nov.</sup> ~~October~~ 1991 and does not now possess said license and further does not know of its whereabouts.
4. That any reapplication for licensure must be preapproved by the Board of Examiners for Nursing.
5. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
6. That she understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
7. That she understands this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.

8. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
9. That she permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the basis for said Consent Order to the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing. She understands that the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or granted.
10. That if this Consent Order is not approved and/or granted on or before December 1, 1991 this Consent Order shall be null and void and nothing contained herein shall be deemed an admission.
11. That she understands she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.


