MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The Board of Examiners for Nursing was presented by the Department of Health Services with a Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges dated February 15, 1984.

The Statement of Charges alleged violations of certain provisions of Chapter 378, Connecticut General Statutes. The Notice of Hearing provided that the hearing would take place on March 13, 1984 in the State Armory, 360 Broad Street, Hartford, Connecticut.

Each member of the Board of Examiners for Nursing involved in this decision attests that he/she has reviewed the record, and that this decision is based entirely on the record.

FACT

1. Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes, Section 4-182(c), Jeanne Hyde, the respondent was provided a full opportunity prior to the institution of agency action to show compliance with all the terms for the retention of his/her license.

2. The respondent: a) On or about September 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 29, 1983 practiced nursing at Brook Hollow Health Care Center with full knowledge that her license to practice nursing was under suspension.

3. The activities referenced in paragraph two (2) were discovered by Division of Medical Quality Assurance Investigator, Thomas S. O'Grady Department of Health Services and Detective Glenn O'Dell, Wallingford Police Department during investigations conducted during October, 1983.

#### DISCUSSION

4. Counts One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven, Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen, Fourteen, Fifteen and Sixteen allege that the respondent violated provisions of Section 20-99(b) by working as a nurse at Brook Hollow Health Care Center while her license to practice nursing was under suspension.

The inescapable conclusion to draw from the facts found by the Board is that the respondent has violated Section 20-99(b) as specified in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh, Twelfth, Thirteenth, Fourteen, Fifteenth, And Sixteenth Counts.

#### ORDER

5. It is the unanimous decision of the Board of Examiners for Nursing that:

- a. The license of the respondent be suspended for a minimum period of six (6) months determined as follows:

- i. As to Counts One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven, Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen, Fourteen, Fifteen and Sixteen, suspension for six (6) months for each Count. The periods of suspension run concurrently, for a total effective suspension of six (6) months. This suspension is to commence September 1, 1984, i.e., at the conclusion of the suspension currently in effect.
  - b. At the end of the six (6) month suspension ordered herein the respondent may apply for reinstatement after meeting the conditions for reinstatement specified in paragraphs 4 and 5 of the consent order signed by the respondent and accepted by the Board of Examiners for Nursing on August 2, 1983, a copy of which is attached hereto.
6. The Board of Examiners for Nursing herewith advises the Department of Health Services of the State of Connecticut of this decision and directs that the registration license of Jean Hyde be suspended in accordance herewith.
