CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Mary L. Barone of Stamford, Connecticut has been issued license number 013742 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Mary L. Barone hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. During November of 1986 and subsequent thereto, while employed as a nurse at Norwalk Hospital in Norwalk, Connecticut she diverted to herself the controlled substance Demerol.
2. During November of 1986 and subsequent thereto, Mary L. Barone abused said drug.
3. During November of 1986 and subsequent thereto, she falsified controlled substances records by forging the name of another nurse.
4. During November of 1986 and subsequent thereto, she diverted controlled substance records.
5. She is licensed as a nurse only in Connecticut and does not have licensure pending in any other state.
6. The conduct described in 1., 2., 3. and 4. above fails to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession in violation of §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, Mary L. Barone hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That her license number 013742 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby revoked.
3. That she shall not apply to another state for a nursing license, or in the alternative she shall (1) notify the Connecticut Department of Health Services and the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing of said application, and (2) provide the licensing Board of the state where she is seeking licensure a copy of this Consent Order.
4. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
5. That she understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
6. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in the event she should at any future time apply for reinstatement of her nursing license.
7. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to

appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

8. That she understands that she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

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I, Mary L. Barone, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
