CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Mary Anne Galipeau (hereinafter "respondent") of Willimantic, Connecticut has been issued license number 015556 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent hereby admits and acknowledges that during October of 1993, while employed at a Department of Mental Retardation group home, she administered three doses of the drug Zantac to a client without a physician's order.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Mary Anne Galipeau hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That respondent waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That respondent shall comply with all federal and state statutes and regulations applicable to her profession.
3. That respondent's license number 015556 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut shall be reprimanded.

4. That this Consent Order is effective on the first day of the month immediately following the month in which this Consent Order is approved and accepted by the Board.
5. That respondent understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
6. That respondent understands this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Board in which (1) her compliance with this same Consent Order is at issue, or (2) her compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
7. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Consent Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
8. That respondent permits a representative of the Department to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. The Department and respondent understands that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
9. That respondent has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Mary Anne Galipeau, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree to the terms set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
