In re: Maureen Marques, L.P.N.

CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Maureen Marques of Coventry, Connecticut has been issued license number 015634 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Maureen Marques hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. During September, 1988, while working as a nurse at Brookview Health Care in West Hartford, Connecticut she diverted to herself the controlled substance methadone.
2. During September, 1988, while working as a nurse as cited in 1. above, she diluted, substituted or otherwise altered the controlled substance methadone.
3. During September, 1988, she abused or utilized to excess said methadone.
4. During March, 1980, she had a disciplinary action taken against her Connecticut nursing license for drug diversion under the name of Maureen Norton.
5. She is licensed as a nurse only in Connecticut and does not have licensure pending in any other state.

6. The conduct described in 1., 2. and 3. above fails to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession in violation of §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Maureen Marques hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That her license number 015634 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is revoked.
3. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
4. That she understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
5. That she understands this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any future proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
6. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this

stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

7. That she permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the basis for said Consent Order to the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing. She understands that the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or granted.
8. That she shall surrender all copies of her current Connecticut nursing license on or before 1 February 1989 to the office of the

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I, Maureen Marques, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
