CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Donna DeBerti, a/k/a/ Donna Rindinello, White Plains, New York has been issued license number 018203 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Donna DeBerti hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. On or about January 21, 1987, the State of New York took disciplinary action against her nursing license for improperly obtaining the controlled substance Demerol and for making false entries in Narcotic Control Sheets.
2. She is licensed as a nurse in Connecticut and has held a nursing license in New York.
3. The conduct described in 1. above fails to conform to the accepted standards of the nursing profession in violation of §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, Donna DeBerti hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.

2. That her license number 018203 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is suspended for two years.
3. That the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing must be informed of any change of address.

5. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing.
6. That she understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
7. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
8. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

9. That she understands that she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Donna DeBerti, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
