CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF
CHRISTINE ANNE RAWSON

WHEREAS, Christine Anne Rawson, L.P.N. of New London, Connecticut has been issued license No. 019294, to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Christine Anne Rawson hereby admits and acknowledges:

1. That between September 14, 1979 and September 25, 1979 she participated in an extortion scheme in Syracuse, New York.
2. That she was charged with Grand Larceny in the first degree and pleaded guilty to Grand Larceny in the Third Degree.
3. That participating in the extortion scheme constitutes conduct which fails to conform to the nursing profession, and therefore violates §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Christine Anne Rawson hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she hereby waives her rights to a hearing on the merits of this matter.

2. That her license No. 019294, to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is suspended until May 16, 1987 effective the first day of the month immediately following the date of the last signatory on this document.
3. That said suspension is stayed under the following conditions:
 - a. That she notifies the Board of Examiners for Nursing of all current employers and any subsequent employers during this probationary periods;
 - b. That she notifies her employers of the probationary status;
 - c. That her immediate supervisor shall submit a report every three months to the Board of Examiners for Nursing, 150 Washington Street, Hartford, Connecticut, indicating the respondent's competency relative to the practice of nursing and her ability to meet current practice standards; the first report shall be filed within seven days of the effective date of this Consent Order.
4. In the event the respondent does not comply with any of the conditions of the probation, the Board of Examiners for Nursing shall review the matter and take further action.
5. That this consent order may be considered as evidence of the admitted violations in any proceeding before the Board of Examiners for Nursing (1) in which her compliance with this order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-99(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, is at issue.
6. That she understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record and can be disseminated to the licensing bodies of other states.

- 7. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
- 8. That she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this agreement.

I, Christine Anne Rawson hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.


