CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Kathleen Bonvouloir (hereinafter "respondent") of West Hartford, Connecticut has been issued license number 022672 to practice as a licensed practical nurse by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. Pursuant to a Consent Order dated June 6, 2001, respondent's license was placed on probation for a period of three years. Such disciplinary action was based upon respondent's admitted diversion of twelve percocet tablets from a client in August and September of 2000.
2. Said Order specifically provided that respondent shall comply with all federal and state statutes and regulations applicable to her profession, and that respondent shall notify the Board and the Department in writing of any change of employment within fifteen (15) days of such change.

3. In approximately November 2002, while employed at the Newington Dialysis Center, respondent showed a patient a picture of her naked boyfriend. Respondent was terminated from the facility for sexual harassment and unprofessional behavior. Respondent failed to notify the Department of the change in her employment as required by the Consent Order.
4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes violations of the terms of probation as set forth in the Consent Order, and subjects respondent's license to revocation or other disciplinary action authorized by the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-17 and 20-99(b).

WHEREAS, respondent, in consideration of this Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the above allegations at a hearing in front of the Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter "the Board").

Respondent further agrees that this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if ordered after a full hearing pursuant to §§19a-9, 19a-10, and 20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-99(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. Respondent waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. Respondent shall comply with all federal and state statutes and regulations applicable to her profession.
3. Respondent's license number 022672 to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Connecticut is hereby reprimanded.
4. This Consent Order is effective on the first day of the month immediately following the month in which this Consent Order is approved and accepted by the Board.


5. Legal notice of any action shall be deemed sufficient if sent to respondent's last known address of record reported to the Office of Practitioner Licensing and Certification of the Bureau of Healthcare Systems of the Department.
6. Respondent understands this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
7. Respondent understands this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Board in which (1) her compliance with this same Consent Order is at issue, or (2) her compliance with §20-99(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
8. This Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Consent Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any other rights that respondent may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
9. Respondent permits a representative of the Department to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. The Department and respondent understand that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
10. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Kathleen Bonvouloir, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree to the terms set forth therein.

I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.


