**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Mark Jablonski:


[COUNT ONE] Only if more than One Count

1. Mark Jablonski of Milford (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut licensed practical nurse license number 025502.
2. On or about November 4, 2004, respondent was arrested for shoplifting. While he was being booked at police headquarters, he was found to be in possession of cocaine.
3. On or about November 4, 2004, respondent was charged with Larceny 6th Degree (C.G.S. §52a-125b) and Possession of Cocaine (C.G.S. §21-279c).
4. The above facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-99(b), including but not limited to §20-99(b)(2).

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing, as authorized by the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§20-99(b) and 19a-17, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the license of Mark Jablonski as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
