Dear Ms. Kennedy:

This is in regard to your Connecticut Practical Nurse license that was granted on March 7, 2002 in accordance with the terms of your Pre-licensure Consent Order, Petition No. 2002-0116-000-004.

Pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Pre-licensure Consent order, any deviation from the terms(s) of the Pre-licensure Consent Order without prior written approval of the Department of Public Health shall constitute a violation. A violation of any term(s) of the order shall result in the right of the Department, at its discretion, to immediately deem your practical nurse license rescinded.

Please be advised that the Department has determined that you have violated the terms of your Pre-licensure Consent Order in that:

- In November 2002 you were fired from your job as an LPN at Silverspring Nursing Home for failure to follow physician orders.
- In July 2003 you were fired from your job as an LPN at Walnut Hill Care Center for poor attendance and documentation errors.
- In November 2004 you were fired from your job as an LPN at Haven Health Care for tardiness and absenteeism and
- On 3/10/05, the Department was informed by Brookview Healthcare that you were being terminated for not meeting the objectives of your position and not practicing with reasonable skill and safety.

The Department believes that these reports of your employment status reflect violations of paragraph 3(e), which requires that you continue to practice with reasonable skill and safety.

As a result of these violations, the Department has determined to rescind your license effective the date of this letter. Please note that pursuant to paragraph 7, you waived any right to a hearing on the issue of violations of the terms of the Order.
