STATEMENT OF CHARGES


Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Chastity Overby:

1. Chastity Overby of Plainville, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut Licensed Practical license number 030552.
2. On September 26, 2002 respondent was convicted of Possession of Narcotics with the Intent to Sell which is classified as a felony.
3. In May 2004 respondent submitted an Application for Licensure to Practice as a Practical nurse.
4. When asked in said application whether she "ever been found guilty or convicted as a result of ... a felony," respondent fraudulently answered "no."
5. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, 20-99(b), including but not limited to 20-99(b)(1).

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Board of Examiners for Nursing, as authorized in §§19a-17 and 20-99(a), revoke or order other disciplinary action against the Licensed Practical license of Chastity Overby as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
