MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

INTRODUCTION

On April 27, 1994 the Board of Examiners for Nursing (hereinafter the "Board") accepted and approved an Interim Consent Order in which it was stipulated and agreed to by the Board, by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services (hereinafter the "Department") and by Franklin Rector (hereinafter the "Respondent") that the Respondent would not practice nursing during the pendency of proceedings against him. (Department Exhibit 1-A)

The Board was presented by the Department with a Statement of Charges dated July 26, 1994. The Statement of Charges, in two (2) counts, alleged violations of certain provisions of Chapter 378 of the General Statutes of Connecticut by the Respondent.

The Board issued a Notice of Hearing dated October 13, 1994 scheduling a hearing for December 7, 1994 (Department Exhibit 1). The hearing took place on December 7, 1994 in Room 2-A, Legislative Office Building, Capitol Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut.

During the hearing on December 7, 1994 the Respondent presented a Motion for Order Without Oral Testimony. Due to a lack of a quorum on the date of the hearing the Board did not act on the Respondent's motion and the hearing proceeded. (Hearing Transcript, December 7, 1994, pp. 10-16)
