In re: Janet Turansky Callaghan

CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Janet Turansky Callaghan, of Armonk, New York, has been issued license number 1769, to practice speech pathology by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 399 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Janet Turansky Callaghan, hereinafter referred to as the Respondent, hereby admits as follows:


1. That, in October and/or November 1987, unauthorized signatures appeared on her Out of State License Verification form and on licensure supporting documents;
2. That she should have known that such unauthorized signatures appeared on said documents;
3. That by her actions in (1) and (2) above she has violated the provisions of §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut by obtaining a license by means of fraud or material misrepresentation.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Janet Turansky Callaghan hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives her right to a compliance conference.
2. That her license to practice speech pathology is hereby voluntarily revoked. Said license shall be forwarded to the Department of Health Services, 150 Washington Street, Hartford, CT. 06106 along with the executed Consent Order.
3. That she waives her right to reapply for a license to practice speech pathology in Connecticut.

4. That she understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
5. That this Consent Order shall become effective on the day the seal of the last signatory is fixed to this document.
6. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of Health Services, his representative or agent (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
7. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
8. This Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Health Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
9. That she permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Connecticut Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for said Consent Order to the Commissioner of Health Services, his representative or agent. She understands that said Commissioner, his representative or agent has complete and final discretion as to whether or not an executed Consent Order is approved or granted.
10. That she has consulted with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Janet Turansky Callaghan, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
