CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Louise Beaver of Hartford, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") has been issued license number 026538 to practice hairdressing and cosmetology by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 387 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Department alleges that:

1. Respondent has been at all times referenced in this Consent Order, the owner and manager of Louise Beauty Barber Salon in Bloomfield, Connecticut.
2. From on or about June 15, 1994, to at least July 14, 1995, respondent employed Anthony Hall to engage in the activities of a licensed hairdresser and cosmetician at Louise Beauty Barber Salon. At such time, Mr. Hall was not licensed as a hairdresser and cosmetician or as a barber in Connecticut.
3. On or about July 14, 1995, respondent authorized Dion Owens, who was not licensed as a hairdresser and cosmetician or as a barber in Connecticut, to engage in the activities of a hairdresser and cosmetician at Louise Beauty Barber Salon, which he did.
4. On or about July 14, 1995, respondent's license was not conspicuously displayed within Louise Beauty Barber Salon.

5. On or about July 14, 1995, unsanitary conditions existed at Louise Beauty Barber Salon.
6. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-263, read in conjunction with §§20-253 and 20-257.

WHEREAS, respondent, in consideration of this Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the above allegations of wrongdoing but, while admitting no guilt or wrongdoing, agrees that for purposes of this or any future proceedings before the Connecticut Examining Board for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians (hereinafter "the Board"), this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if proven and ordered after a full hearing held pursuant to §§19a-10 and 20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §§19a-17 and 20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Loiose Beaver hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. Respondent waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. Respondent's license number 026538 to practice as a hairdresser and cosmetician in the State of Connecticut is hereby reprimanded.
3. Respondent shall comply with all state and federal statutes and regulations applicable to her licensure.
4. Respondent understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
5. This Consent Order is effective on the first day of the month immediately following the date this Consent Order is accepted and ordered by the Board.
6. Respondent agrees that the Department's allegations as contained in this Consent Order shall be deemed true in any subsequent proceeding before the Board in which her compliance with §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.

7. This Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
8. This Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
9. Respondent permits a representative of the Legal Office of the Bureau of Regulatory Services to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. Respondent understands that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether this executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
10. Respondent has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

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I, Louise Beaver, have read the above Consent Order, and I stipulate and agree to the terms as set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
