CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Gloria Elias of Hartford, Connecticut has been issued license number 37693 to practice as a hairdresser and cosmetician by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 387 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Gloria Elias hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. On January 17, 1986, the State of Connecticut Department of Health Services, Division of Medical Quality Assurance issued to her a license to practice as a hairdresser and cosmetician within this State.
2. During January of 1986, she began employment as the manager of Cut to Perfection Beauty Salon, a hairdressing shop located in Hartford, Connecticut, without the requisite two years experience as a registered hairdresser and cosmetician.
3. By her actions described in paragraphs 2. above, she has violated the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §20-258 and §20-263.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-263 of the Connecticut General Statutes, Gloria Elias hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter;

2. That she is hereby reprimanded;
3. That she is assessed a civil penalty of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). Said penalty is to be paid to the Treasurer, State of Connecticut, by certified check forwarded to:

Payment of said penalty shall accompany this document upon execution by the Respondent;

4. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the month immediately following the date said Consent Order is ordered and accepted by the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians;
5. That she understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record;
6. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Barbers, Hairdressers & Cosmeticians (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue;
7. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

8. That she understands that she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Gloria Elias, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
