CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Sofia Leykikh, H.C., of West Hartford, Connecticut, has been issued license number 042637, to practice hairdressing and cosmetology by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 387 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Sofia Leykikh, H.C., hereinafter referred to as the Respondent, hereby admits as follows:

1. On 16 January 1992 she gave a permanent and haircut to Nancy Kimbrough.
2. Said permanent and haircut failed to conform to the standard of practice for hairdressers.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Sofia Leykikh hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives her right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. Within one year of the effective date of this Consent Order she shall take and successfully complete one course in the application of permanent wave products. Such course shall last no less than two (2) days and shall be given for Family Haircut Store by Zotos Company. Proof of successful completion shall be sent to:

3. She has successfully completed a course in basic application of color products given 29 and 30 September 1992 by Family Haircut Store training series.
4. Any deviation by the Respondent from the terms specified in this Consent Order shall constitute a violation of the Consent Order and will result in the following procedure:
 - a. She will be notified in writing that the term(s) of the Consent Order have been violated provided no prior written consent for deviation from the term(s) had been granted by the Department of Health Services.
 - b. Said notification shall include the act(s) or omission(s) which violate the Consent Order.
 - c. She will be allowed fifteen (15) days to demonstrate to the Department of Health Services that she was in compliance with the terms of the Consent Order, or to cure the violation of the terms of the Consent Order.
 - d. If she does not demonstrate compliance or cure the violation by the limited fifteen (15) day date certain contained in the notification of violation to the satisfaction of the Department of Health Services, her license shall be suspended unless she initiates a hearing as described in paragraph 5.e. below, at the Respondent's option.

8. This Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is fixed to this document.
9. She permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Connecticut Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for said Consent Order to the agent of the Commissioner. She understands that said agent has complete and final discretion as to whether or not an executed Consent Order is approved or granted. She further agrees that the pre-hearing review form signed by her is incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.
10. That she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.
