STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§ 19a-10 and 19a-14, The Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Julia Simmons:

1. Julia Simmons of Norwalk, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") is licensed to practice hairdressing in Connecticut and was managing the Styles & Motion Hair Salon.
2. From February, 2004 until April, 2006 respondent employed an unlicensed hairdresser at Styles & Motion Hair Salon.
3. The above described act constitutes grounds for disciplinary action under §20-252 under the General Statutes of Connecticut.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Examining Board for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians, as authorized in §§ 19a-17 and 20-252, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the hairdressing license of Julia Simmons as it deems appropriate and consistent with the law.
