PRE-LICENSURE CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Victor M. Zukowski of New Haven, Connecticut, hereinafter referred to as the Respondent, has made application to be licensed as a licensed hairdresser/cosmetologist by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services pursuant to Chapter 387 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Respondent hereby admits that between March and June, 1993 he practiced hairdressing/cosmetology without a Connecticut license; and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-14 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, the Respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. Subject to completion of all requirements for licensure with the Connecticut Department of Public Health and Addiction Services, and compliance with the terms of this Order, the Respondent shall be issued a license as a hairdresser/cosmetologist.
2. Until and unless the Respondent has been issued a license as a hairdresser/cosmetologist, he shall refrain from the practice of that profession.
3. The Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$250.00 on or by July 30, 1993.

4. If the Respondent does not successfully and timely complete the conditions specified above, he will not be issued a license as a hairdresser/cosmtologist.
5. Any deviation from the term(s) of this Agreement without prior written approval of the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services shall constitute a violation. A violation of any term(s) of this Agreement shall result in the right of the Department to immediately deem any hairdresser/cosmetologist's license issued to him in reliance upon his performance of such terms rescinded. Any extension of time or grace period for compliance with this Order granted by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services shall not be a waiver or preclude the Department's right to take action at a later time. The Department of Public Health and Addiction Services shall not be required to grant future extensions of time or grace periods. Any notice of the rescision of the Respondent's hairdresser's/cosmetologist's license shall be sent by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services to the Respondent's address of record (most current address reported to the Licensure and Registration Section of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance of the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services). The Respondent waives his right to a hearing on the issue of violation of the terms of this Order.

7. The Respondent understands that the admissions contained in this Pre-licensure Agreement may be considered as evidence in any future

proceeding before the Board of Examiners for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians in which his compliance with §20-250, et seq of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.

8. The Respondent understands this Order is a matter of public record.
9. This Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive the Respondent of any rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
10. This Order is a revocable settlement offer which may be modified in writing by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Public Health and Addiction Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
11. The Respondent understands that he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

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


