**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**


Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Anthony Riley:

1. Donovan Barker of Norwich, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") was issued license number 045996 to practice hairdressing and cosmetology. Said license lapsed due to non-renewal on April 30, 2002.
2. From May 2003 until April 2004 respondent engaged in the practice of hairdressing without having a license.
3. The above described facts constitutes violations of General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-252.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Examining Board for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians, as authorized in §§19a-11 and 19a-17, order that respondent immediately cease and desist practicing hairdressing and cosmetology.
