**STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Maria Silva:

1. Maria Silva of Danbury, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") has at no time been issued a license to practice hairdressing and cosmetology.
2. In 2005 respondent engaged in the practice of hairdressing without having a license.
3. The above described facts constitutes violations of General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-252.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Connecticut Examining Board for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians, as authorized in §§19a-11 and 19a-17, order that respondent immediately cease and desist practicing hairdressing and cosmetology.
