CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF

RONALD A. CAPASSO

WHEREAS, Ronald A. Capasso barber, of New Haven, Connecticut has been issued license No. 287, to practice as a barber by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 386 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Ronald A. Capasso hereby acknowledges and admits that he:

1. Is the owner of a barber shop in New Haven, Connecticut.
2. In his capacity as owner, has employed a unlicensed person to perform as a barber or hairdresser at said shop.
3. Recognizes that the providing or performing of such hairdressing or barbering services by persons not properly licensed to do so is a violation of the provisions of §20-238 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-238 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Ronald A. Capasso hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he is hereby reprimanded for violation of §20-238 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
2. That he will immediately cease and desist from providing or from permitting to be performed hairdressing or barbering services by persons not properly licensed to do so at his barber shop in New Haven and at any other location that he may own, operate, or manage in the State of Connecticut.
3. That he understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
4. That he understands that this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any future proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians arising out of a subsequent series of facts (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-238 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
5. That he understands that this Consent Order shall be considered dispositive of the matters herein described and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, it is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 386 and Chapter 54 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
6. That he understands that he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.


