CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF
JOSEPH LUCA

WHEREAS, Joseph Luca, hairdresser, of New Britain, Connecticut has been issued license No. 013375, to practice as a hairdresser by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 387 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Luca hereby acknowledges and admits that he:

1. Is the owner of, a hairdressing salon in New Britain, Connecticut.
2. In his capacity as owner, has employed a unlicensed person to perform hairdressing services at said salon.
3. Recognizes that the providing or performing of such hairdressing services by hairdressers or other persons not properly licensed to do so is a violation of the provisions of §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Joseph Luca hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he will immediately cease and desist from providing or from permitting to be performed hairdressing services by persons not properly licensed to do so at his hairdressing salon in New Britain and


at any other location that he may own, operate, or manage in the State of Connecticut.

2. That he understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
3. That he understands that this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Examiners for Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmeticians (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
4. That he understands that this Consent Order is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, it is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 387 and Chapter 54 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
5. That he understands that he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this to be an act performed of my own free will.




