REINSTATEMENT CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, John Crandall, R.P.T. of Durham, Connecticut (hereinafter "respondent") was issued license number 001024 to practice as a respiratory care practitioner by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 381a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent's license expired on January 31, 2006, and respondent has now applied to have said license reinstated by the Department pursuant to Chapter 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,


WHEREAS, respondent hereby admits as follows:

1. Respondent practiced as a respiratory care practitioner at various times after his license lapsed, including but not limited to various times in 2006 when he worked for Goldstar Medical Services and/or Peoples Medical and from on or about April 1, 2008 through on or about September 25, 2009 when he worked for Subacute Center Of Bristol; and
2. The conduct described above constitutes grounds for denial of respondent's application for reinstatement pursuant to §19a-14(a)(6) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §§19a-17 and 20-162p of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, respondent hereby stipulates and agrees as follows:


1. He waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. Respondent's license to practice as a respiratory care practitioner shall be reinstated when he satisfies the requirements for reinstatement of his license, as set forth in §§ 19a-14-1 through 19a-14-5, inclusive, of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, and this Reinstatement Consent Order is executed by all parties.
3. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) by certified or cashier's check payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut." The check shall reference the
