CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, R. Glen Zeh, M.F.T., of Raymond Place, Danbury, Connecticut, has been issued certificate number 000214, to practice as a Marriage and Family Therapist by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 383a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, R. Glen Zeh, M.F.T., hereinafter referred to as the Respondent, hereby admits as follows:

1. That on February 27, 1991, the Ethics Committee of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) found him in violation of professional standards.
2. That his membership in the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy was terminated effective April 15, 1991.
3. That the conduct in (1) and (2) above subjects him to disciplinary action pursuant to the provisions of §20-195d of the General Statutes of Connecticut for the failure to conform to the accepted standards of his profession.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-195d of the General Statutes of Connecticut, R. Glen Zeh hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:


1. That he waives his right to a compliance conference and a hearing on the merits of this matter.

2. That he hereby surrenders his certificate number 000214 to practice as a Marriage and Family Therapist. Said certificate shall accompany this executed Consent Order.
3. That he shall not represent himself as a "Connecticut Certified Marital and Family Therapist" in any practice that he may engage in.
4. That he understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Department of Health Services (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-195d of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
6. That this Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Health Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
7. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which it is accepted and ordered by the last signatory.
8. That he has consulted with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, R. Glen Zeh, M.F.T., have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
