STATEMENT OF CHARGES


Pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §§19a-10 and 19a-14, the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") brings the following charges against Peter G. Ferragatta:

1. Peter G. Ferragatta of Plainfield (hereinafter "respondent") is, and has been at all times referenced in this Statement of Charges, the holder of Connecticut massage therapy license number 002965.
2. During 2001 and/or 2002, respondent surreptitiously videotaped Jennifer Smith while she was undressing in preparation for a massage.
3. During April of 2001, respondent surreptitiously videotaped Camille Iozzia while she was undressing in preparation for a massage.
4. During November of 2001, respondent surreptitiously videotaped Gabriele Keegan while she was undressing in preparation for a massage.
5. The above-described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-206c.

THEREFORE, the Department prays that:

The Commissioner, as authorized in §§19a-17 and 20-206c, revoke or order other disciplinary action against the massage therapy license of Peter G. Ferragatta as it deems appropriate and consistent with law.
