CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Fletcher DomBrosky, Waterford, Connecticut, has been issued license No. 255, to practice as a subsurface sewage disposal system installer by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter , 393a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Fletcher DomBrosky hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. Since on or before 1 January 1980 he has been an officer and the responsible subsurface sewage disposal system installer of Fletcher's Septic Tank Co., Waterford, Connecticut;
2. Since on or before 1 January 1980 Fletcher's Septic Tank Co. has serviced the account of Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, Millstone Power Station, Waterford, Connecticut; Between January 1980 and February 1984 Fletcher's Septic Tank Co. improperly disposed of non-toxic waste removed from holding tanks at said account;
3. By his actions described in 1. through 3. above he has violated the provisions of §20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut by failing to conform to the accepted standards of the subsurface sewage disposal system installers profession.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-341f of the Connecticut General Statutes, Fletcher DomBrosky hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:


1. That he waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter;
2. That he is hereby assessed a civil fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) said penalty to be paid to the Treasurer, State of Connecticut, by certified check forwarded to the Public Health Hearing Office, Department of Health Services, 150 Washington Street, Hartford, Connecticut 06106, payment of which shall accompany this document upon execution by the respondent;
3. That his license, No. 255, to practice as a subsurface sewage disposal system installer in the State of Connecticut is suspended for ten years;
4. That his suspension will be stayed after one year subject to the following condition:

That he shall henceforth dispose of sewage in the manner required by the Connecticut General Statutes and regulations promulgated thereunder;

5. That he understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record;
6. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document;
7. That he understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Department of Health Services (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-314f of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue;

- 8. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapter 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any other rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States;
- 9. That he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.


