Consent Order

In re:

Arthur Ruff, Sr.

WHEREAS, Arthur Ruff, Sr. of Glastonbury, Connecticut has been issued subsurface sewage disposal system installer license No. 1242, by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 393a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Arthur Ruff, Sr. hereby admits and acknowledges that:


1. On or before June 24, 1984 he was responsible for the supervision of George Kelley, an installer apprentice;
2. On said date George Kelley failed to properly service the septic system at 779 New Britain Avenue, Rocky Hill, Connecticut;
3. He failed to properly supervise the servicing of said system;
4. By his actions described in (1) through (3) above he has violated the provisions of §20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut by failing to conform to the accepted standards of the subsurface sewage disposal system installer profession.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Arthur Ruff, Sr. hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That he is hereby reprimanded.

3. That he understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
4. That he understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding brought by the Commissioner of Department of Health Services (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-341f of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, is at issue.
5. That he understands that this Consent Order is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further it is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 393a and Chapter 54 of the Connecticut General Statutes, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any other rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
6. That he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Arthur Ruff, Sr., hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this to be an act performed of my own free will.




