CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Carl Hayo, S.S.I., of Wilton, Connecticut, has been issued license number 002618, to practice as a subsurface sewage disposal system installer by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 393a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health Services alleges that:

1. Carl Hayo was employed by Parisi Construction Co. of Norwalk, CT;
2. Parisi Construction Co. installed a septic system at 491 Nod Hill Road, Wilton, Connecticut;
3. He performed licensed services, including installing the pipes of the leaching system;
4. Unsuitable fill material was deposited in the system;
5. Although he did not select or deposit the fill material, he is responsible for it because of the work he did on the system;
6. He has failed to conform to the acceptable standards of the subsurface sewage disposal system installer profession and therefore violated Connecticut General Statutes §20-341f; and

WHEREAS, Carl Hayo does not admit to the allegations above and does not admit to a violation of Connecticut General Statutes §20-341f, but in consideration of this

Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the above allegations of wrongdoing. Carl Hayo, while admitting no guilt or wrongdoing, agrees that for purposes of proceedings before the Department of Health Services, in which his installer license is at issue, the above allegations and this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if proven and ordered after a full hearing held pursuant to Sections 19a-9, 19a-10, and 20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Carl Hayo hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter;
2. That his subsurface sewage disposal system installer license is hereby censured.
3. That he is assessed a \$500.00 civil penalty. A certified check made payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut" shall accompany this Consent Order upon execution by the Respondent.
4. That he understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above violations in any proceeding before the Department of Health Services (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-341f of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.

6. That this Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Health Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
7. That this Consent Order is effective when the last signatory is fixed to this document.
8. That he has consulted with an attorney prior to signing this document.

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
