PRE-LICENSURE CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Roddy Geddes of Bethlehem, Connecticut, hereinafter referred to as the respondent, has made application to be licensed as an Subsurface Sewage Disposal System Installer by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapters 368s and 393a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

Roddy Geddes previously held Subsurface System Installer license number ~~F-1750~~¹⁰⁵⁰⁹⁴, which expired in 1986 when he failed to renew it; and

WHEREAS Roddy Geddes installed a new sewer system for lot 2A, Upper Grassy Hill Road, Woodbury, Connecticut in October of 1992 without a subsurface sewage disposal system installer's license, and without first obtaining a permit to install as required by the Connecticut Health Code; and

WHEREAS the above conduct constitutes violations of Connecticut General Statutes §20-341f(a), §20-341f(d), and §20-341g;


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-14 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, the respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That subject to completion of all requirements for licensure with the Connecticut Department of Health Services and the special condition recited hereinafter, the respondent shall be issued a license as a subsurface sewage disposal system installer:

- A. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$500.00 to the Connecticut Department of Health Services on or before April 30, 1993;
2. That if the respondent does not pay the civil penalty specified above, the respondent will not be issued a license.
 3. That all correspondence and reports are to be addressed to:

 4. That the respondent understands this Pre-Licensure Consent Order may be considered as evidence in any future proceeding before the Commissioner of Health Services in which the respondent's compliance with Chapter 393a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
 5. That the respondent understands this Stipulated Agreement is a matter of public record.
 6. That this Stipulated Agreement and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said Agreement is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of chapters 54 and 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive the respondent of any rights that the respondent may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
 7. That this Stipulated Agreement is a revocable offer which may be modified in writing by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Health Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
 8. That the respondent understands he has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Roddy Geddes, have read the above Stipulated Agreement, and I agree to the terms set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Stipulated Agreement to be my free act and deed.


