
RECOMMENDED DECISION

The undersigned Hearing Officer conducted a hearing on November 13, 1985 in regard to the above-referenced matter, which was initiated by a Notice of Hearing dated September 19, 1985. Said Notice incorporated six counts as set forth in a companion Statement of Charges dated June 28, 1985.

The Respondent failed to appear on November 13, 1985 despite the fact that he had actual notice of such hearing and offered no reasons for his failure to appear. The Respondent was further given an additional thirty days to present any evidence or information that he might have in defense to the charges listed. He has failed to do so.

The undersigned finds as a result of the evidence submitted, that the State proved that the Respondent did, in fact, violate Sections 20-314f(d)(2) and 20-314f(d)(3) of the Connecticut State Statutes as set forth in Counts One through Six of the Statement of Charges, and recommends that the Commissioner revoke the license of the Respondent to practice as a subsurface sewage disposal system installer.
