CONSENT DECREE

IN THE MATTER OF  
JULIUS CZERMAK

WHEREAS, I, Julius Czermak of 1070 East 23rd Street, Brooklyn, New York 11210, have been issued a license, No. 149, to practice as a nursing home administrator by the Commissioner of Health Services pursuant to § 19-595 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, I, Julius Czermak, pleaded nolo contendere in Superior Court, Geographical Area Eight, West Haven, Connecticut, to 25 counts of violation of § 19-13D8(e)(8) of the Public Health Code that had occurred in the Breakers Convalescent Home in West Haven, Connecticut, while I was the administrator thereof; and


WHEREAS, as a result of said plea, I, Julius Czermak, was found guilty on all counts by Superior Court Justice Norton M. Levine on the 7th day of December 1981; and

WHEREAS, each of the above violations constitutes a violation of § 19-598 (b)(3) of the General Statutes as amended;


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of § 19-598(a) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, I, Julius Czermak, not wishing to contest the charges of said violations, do hereby stipulate and agree to the following:

1. That my license, No. 149, to practice as a nursing home administrator in the state of Connecticut shall be suspended for a period of one year with said suspension to be effected on the first day of the month following the effective date of this document;
2. By said suspension, I, Julius Czermak, relinquish my right and interest to practice as a nursing home administrator in the State of Connecticut for a period of one year as aforesaid;
3. At the end of the said one year period of suspension, license No. 149, to practice as a nursing home administrator, with all the rights, privileges, and responsibilities appertaining thereto, is to be restored to me, Julius Czermak, provided the renewal fee therefor has been timely paid as set forth in § 19-45(e) of the General Statutes of Connecticut;
4. This suspension of license No. 149 and any determination made under the terms of this consent decree by the Commissioner of Health Services or his duly appointed agent are not subject to reconsideration or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Moreover, any further determination made under the terms of this consent decree by the Commissioner of Health Services or his duly appointed agent is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 54 and 333, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive me, Julius Czermak, of any other rights that I may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or the United States.


I hereby affix my signature, stipulating and agreeing to the above, and declare this consent decree to be an act performed of my own free will.
