

VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT NOT TO RENEW OR REINSTATE LICENSE


Barry Hultman, being duly sworn, deposes and says:


1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. I was licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice as a nursing home administrator. My license number 000937 lapsed on April 30, 1998 when I did not renew it.
4. I hereby voluntarily agree not to renew or reinstate my license to practice as a nursing home administrator in the State of Connecticut.
5. I understand and agree that if I seek a new license or to reinstate my license at any time in the future, the allegations attached as Appendix A shall be deemed true. I further understand that any such application must be made to the Department, which shall have absolute discretion as to whether said license shall be issued or reinstated and, if so, whether said license shall be subject to conditions.
6. I hereby waive any right to a hearing I may have regarding any request that my license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that I may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. I understand and agree that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 970408-036-003 are public documents, and I am executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. I understand that, upon execution of this document by the Department, the Department will present this document to the Public Health Hearing Office and will move to withdraw the Statement of Charges in Petition No. 970408-036-003. I understand that this document is not effective unless and until the Department has executed it, and the Public Health Hearing Office either grants the Department's Motion to Withdraw or the charges are dismissed.

9. I understand that I have the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.

APPENDIX A

Respondent was negligent in the conduct of his practice as a licensed nursing home administrator, in violation of section 19a-517 of the general statutes, in one or more of the following ways:

- a) In violation of §19-13-D8t(f)(3)(A); he failed to enforce proper bookkeeping and recordkeeping at Countryside Manor in compliance with the requirements of federal Medicaid reimbursement regulations and the requirements of the Provider Agreement between Countryside Manor and the Connecticut Department of Social Services;
- b) He failed to ensure proper accounting of transfers of Countryside Manor and personal funds; and
- c) He failed to ensure proper accounting of Countryside Manor and non-patient care expenses.
