CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF
ALBERT SQUILLACOTE

WHEREAS, Albert Squillacote, 300 Main Street, New Britain, Connecticut has been issued Hearing Aid Dealer license No. 57, to practice by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 398 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Albert Squillacote hereby admits that:

1. He failed to refund the fee paid by a customer when the hearing aid was returned within the thirty day grace period.
2. By his actions described in (1) above has violated the provisions of §20-402a.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-404 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Albert Squillacote hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he is hereby waiving his rights to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That he is hereby reprimanded for violation of §20-402a of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

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QUALITY ASSURANCE

3. That he will at all times in the future obey both the letter and the spirit of the law.
4. That he is hereby assessed a penalty of \$200.00 for failing to comply with the provisions of §20-204a of the Connecticut General Statutes. Said penalty is to be paid to the Treasurer, State of Connecticut, forwarded to Hearing Office, 150 Washington Street, Hartford 06106 within 10 days after the effective date of this document.
5. That this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of the Department of Health Services (1) in which his compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-402a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
6. That this consent order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 54, and 398 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any other rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
7. That he understands that notice of this Consent Order will be disseminated to the licensing bodies of other states.
8. That this consent order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.
9. That he has been informed of his right to consult with an attorney before signing this document.

I, Albert Squillacote, hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and delare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
