CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Nancy Trostler, <sup>N.T.</sup> ~~98 York Street, New Haven,~~ <sup>464 Ocean Ave. New London,</sup> Connecticut has been issued Audiologist License No. 121 and Hearing Aid Dealer License No. 00147 by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 398 and 399 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Nancy Trostler hereby admits:


1. During July of 1983 she advertised in the Norwich Bulletin in behalf of her business "County Hearing and Balance, Inc." that (hearing) "evaluations are covered by Medicare."
2. That some evaluations are not covered by Medicare.
3. That this conduct, although unintentional and inadvertent is misleading and deceptive and violates §20-404 and §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17, §20-404 and §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Nancy Trostler hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:


1. That she waives <sup>N.T.</sup> ~~his~~ <sup>her</sup> right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That she is hereby reprimanded for violation of §20-404 and §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
3. That henceforth she will not use any deception or misleading advertising.

4. That this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of Health Services (1) in which ~~his~~<sup>her N.T.</sup> compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which ~~his~~<sup>her N.T.</sup> compliance with §20-404 and §20-414 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this consent order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 54, 398 and 399 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive ~~him~~<sup>her N.T.</sup> of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
6. That she understands that notice of this Consent Order will be disseminated to the licensing bodies of other states.
7. That this consent order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.
8. That she has consulted with an attorney before signing this document.

I, Nancy Trostler, hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
