CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF  
JULIE TREMBLAY, D.V.M.

WHEREAS, Julie Tremblay, D.V.M. of 330 Main Street, East Haven, Connecticut has been issued license No. 1147, to practice veterinary medicine by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 384 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Julie Tremblay, D.V.M. hereby admits and acknowledges:

1. In July 1983 she disposed of an animal left in her care by its owner by placing said animal with a new owner, after the initial owner refused to pay for euthanasia services.
2. In July 1983 she placed the aforesaid abandoned animal with a new owner without giving proper notice of said disposition or action to the prior owner, pursuant to the notice requirements of §20-205a of the Connecticut General Statutes.
3. That the above conduct violates §20-202(4) of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Julie Tremblay hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she hereby waives her rights to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
2. That she is hereby reprimanded.

3. That she will cease and desist from disposing of animals abandoned at her establishment and placing said animals with new owners without giving notice of her intent to do so to the prior owners, in accordance with the provisions of §20-205a of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
4. That this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the admitted violations in any proceeding before the Connecticut Board of Veterinary Registration and Examination (1) in which her compliance with this order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-202 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
6. That she understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
7. That she understands that she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this agreement.
8. That this Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.

I, Julie Tremblay, D.V.M., hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
