CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF
MILAD S. LAWENDY, D.V.M.

WHEREAS, Milad S. Lawendy, D.V.M., of Bridgeport, Connecticut, has been issued license No. 1258, by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 384 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, to practice as a veterinarian; and

WHEREAS, Milad S. Lawendy, D.V.M., hereby admits:

1. That he is the sole owner of and sole veterinarian doctor practicing at the Bridgeport Veterinarian Hospital, located at 161 North Avenue, Bridgeport, CT.
2. That on or about December 24, 1982, he left the country on vacation and left the Bridgeport Veterinarian Hospital in the care and control of Sameh S. Solomon, a person not licensed to practice veterinarian medicine in the State of Connecticut.
3. That on or about December 24, 1982, and continuing until on or about December 30, 1982, he ~~was~~^{was} associated with Sameh S. Solomon, a person who unlawfully practiced veterinary medicine at the Bridgeport Veterinarian Hospital, 161 North Avenue, Bridgeport, CT.
4. That the conduct in the practice of his profession as described in 3. and 4. above is a violation of §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

W THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Milad S. Lawendy, D.V.M., hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he waives his right to a hearing on the merits in this matter.
2. That his license, No. 1258, to practice as a veterinarian in the State of Connecticut is ~~suspended~~ for a period of ^{fourteen} ~~thirteen~~ days, effective the first day of the month following the date on which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.
3. That said suspension is ~~stayed~~ and he is placed on ~~probation~~ for a period of two years, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. That he shall not for any period of time leave his practice in the care and control of a person not licensed to practice veterinarian medicine in the State of Connecticut.
 - b. That he shall not knowingly associate himself professionally with persons who unlawfully practice veterinary medicine.
 - c. That, under penalty of perjury, he shall submit semiannually a written report to the Board of Veterinary Registration and Examination, stating (1) the dates of any periods during which he has entrusted his practice to others, the names of said person(s), and the Connecticut License number of said person(s) and (2) that he has complied with all the terms and conditions of probation as set forth herein.
 - d. That he shall obey all state laws governing the practice of veterinarian medicine in the State of Connecticut.

4. That this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Board of Examiners of Veterinarians (1) in which his compliance with the terms of this same order is at issue, or (2) in which his compliance with §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.

5. That, if he violates probation in any respect at any time within the probationary period, the Board of Veterinary Registration and Examination may set aside the stay order and impose suspension of his license for the full ~~thirty~~ ^{ten} days.

6. That upon successful completion of probation, his license will be fully restored.

7. That this suspension, the staying thereof, and the terms and conditions of probation set forth are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapters 54 and 384 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive him of any other rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or the United States.

8. That he has consulted with an attorney before signing this document.

I, Milad S. Lawendy, D.V.M., hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
