CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Dwight Baghdoyan of Williamsburg, Massachusetts (hereinafter "respondent") was issued license number 001791 to practice veterinary medicine by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") pursuant to Chapter 384 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, respondent's license lapsed on March 31, 1993, for failure to renew; and,

WHEREAS, the Department alleges that:

1. On or about February 26, 1993, respondent provided treatment to Lindsay, a great dane, for bloat which treatment included the taking and reading of radiographs.
2. In providing treatment to Lindsay, respondent misinterpreted said radiographs.
3. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §20-202.

WHEREAS, respondent has completed a 20 hour clinical refresher course in radiology at Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, North Grafton, Massachusetts, under the supervision of Lawrence J. Kleine, D.V.M., M.S., Associate Professor, Head of Radiology, Department of Surgery; and,

WHEREAS, respondent, in consideration of this Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the above allegations of wrongdoing but, while admitting no guilt or wrongdoing, agrees that for purposes of this or any future proceedings before the Connecticut Board of Veterinary Medicine (hereinafter "the Board") this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if proven and ordered after a full hearing held pursuant to §19a-9, §19a-14, and §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut; and,

WHEREAS, this fully executed Consent Order fully and finally resolves all allegations contained in Department's Petition No. 930505-47-011.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-202 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, Dwight Baghdoyan hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That he understands that this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
2. That respondent shall enroll in and successfully complete a twenty (20) hour clinical refresher course in radiology at Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, North Grafton, Massachusetts, under the supervision of Lawrence J. Kleine, D.V.M., M.S., Associate Professor, Head of Radiology, Department of Surgery.
3. That the course previously referenced, which respondent has completed, satisfies the requirement set forth in paragraph 2 above.
4. That the Department's allegations as contained in this Consent Order shall be deemed true in any subsequent proceeding before the Board in which (1) his compliance with this Consent Order is at issue, or (2) his compliance with §20-202 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that this Order is not subject to appeal or review under the

6. That this Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the the Department at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
7. That respondent permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance of the Department to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the Board. Respondent understands that the Board has complete and final discretion as to whether an executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
8. That respondent has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

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
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


