CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF

MATHILDE GROSS-KOLWICZ

WHEREAS, Mathilde Gross-Kolwicz, O.T.R. of East Hampton Connecticut, has been issued license No. 320 to practice as an occupational therapist by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 376a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Mathilde Gross-Kolwicz, O.R.T., hereby admits that she:

1. That she failed to provide direct supervision to a holder of a temporary permit, in violation of §20-74d of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. That she failed to ensure the temporary permit was effective prior to commencing the aforementioned supervision.
3. By her actions described in (1) and (2) above, has violated the provisions of §20-74g.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17a and §20-74g of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Mathilde Gross-Kolwicz hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives her rights to a hearing on the merits of the matter.
2. That she is hereby censured for the violation of §20-74d of the Connecticut General Statutes.
3. That henceforth she will ensure that that all supervision she provides will be in complete conformity with the Connecticut General Statutes.

4. That this consent order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of Health Services (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-74g of the the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
5. That this consent order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 54, and 376a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any other rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
6. That she understands that notice of this Consent Order may be disseminated to the licensing bodies of other states.
7. That this consent order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is affixed to this document.
8. That she has the right to consult with an attorney before signing this document.

I, Mathilde Gross-Kolwicz, hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this agreement to be an act performed of my own free will.
