PRELICENSURE AGREEMENT

IN THE MATTER OF

ROBIN CROSSCUP

WHEREAS, Robin Crosscup of 33 Chriswell Drive, Simsbury, Connecticut has applied to the Department of Health Services for a license to practice occupational therapy pursuant to Chapter 376a of the General Statutes of Connecticut as amended; and

WHEREAS, Robin Crosscup of Simsbury, CT is eligible for licensure to practice occupational therapy in the State of Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, Robin Crosscup hereby acknowledges and admits that:

1. From January 23, 1984 and continuing until February 28, 1984 she practiced without a license or a temporary permit.
2. From January 23, 1984 and continuing until March 31, 1984 she practiced without proper supervision.

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to §19a-17 and §20-74g of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, Robin Crosscup hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she is hereby reprimanded for practicing occupational therapy without a license in violation of §20-74f.

2. That she will not practice occupational therapy in Connecticut until she is properly licensed to do so by the Connecticut Department of Health Services.
3. That violation of the terms of this prelicensure agreement may constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Department of Health Services.
4. That she understands that the prelicensure agreement is a matter of public record.
5. That the prelicensure agreement may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violation in any proceeding before the Connecticut Department of Health Services (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-74g of the General Statutes of Connecticut is at issue.
6. That she understands that the prelicensure agreement is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review under any form or forum. Further it is not subject to appeal under the provisions of Chapter 376a and Chapter 54 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.
7. That she understands she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I hereby affix my signature, agreeing and admitting to the above, and declare this to be an act performed of my own free will.


